Is it a 5000K light source?

A new product called the GATF/RHEM Light Indicator can show you immediately if the light source used to view a proof is the standard 5000K. The GATF/RHEM

Light Indicator is a color patch made up of a metameric magenta bar that appears solid under a 5000 K light source but looks striped under other light sources. The patch is adhesive backed and may be placed directly on a proof. Indicators sell for about \$1 a piece (less if you are a GATF member or order in bulk). Page Buffer Disk

Customers using their Linotype-Hell RIP 60 and a Recorder 3020/3030 for output of both PostScript pages and scanner or system pages should take note of an option for the RIP 60 called Page Buffer Disk. Beginning with RIP software version 3.00 it is possible to switch the RIP 60 between direct output mode (DOM) and Page Buffer Mode.

When the RIP 60 is working in Page Buffer Mode the recorder is not occupied by the RIP. Therefore the recorder can do scanner or system output, while the RIP is ripping to disk. After the job is ripped to the Page Buffer Disk, the recorder can then output it.

Macintosh font tips

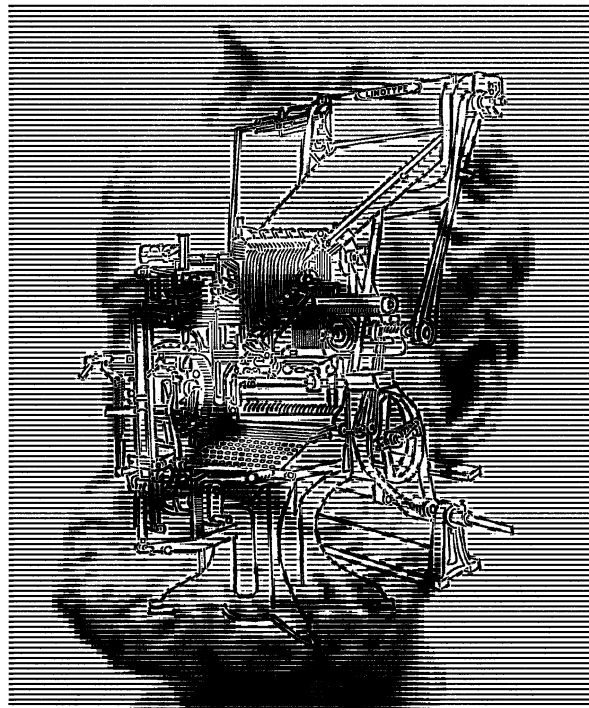

Blends in Adobe Illustrator 5.0/5.01
There is a problem with printing blends created by Adobe Illustrator 5.0 & 5.01. When the job is sent, sometimes the imagesetter will lock up during the printing, or, the RIP will re-boot. Saving the Illustrator file in 3.0 format will usually allow the job to print. Adobe has fixed the problem and intends to release the fix in version 5.5 of Illustrator.
